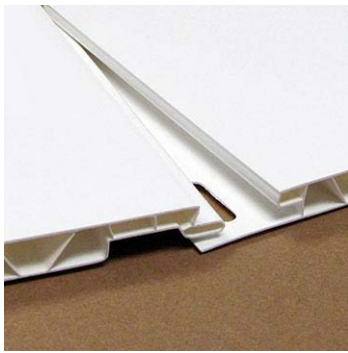

A polycarbonate U-Channel is used to cap off the top and bottom of a multiwall polycarbonate sheet, preventing dust, bugs, and moisture from entering the flutes.

"Drill Weep Holes"

If you are using a U-Channel to cap off the bottom of your multiwall sheet, remember to drill weep holes at least every 12 inches.

Weep holes provide moisture ventilation and allow condensation to drain from the sheet flutes.
