Polycarbonate Roof Survives Two Category 5 Hurricanes



Q: Are there minimum order requirements for purchasing LEXAN™ THERMOCLICK™ sheets?

A: The minimum order quantity or "MOQ" for LEXAN™ THERMOCLICK™ is based on square feet.

Because AmeriLux stocks clear, opal and blue, there is no MOQ to purchase these colors.

Custom or special order colors like green, red, yellow, purple, orange, SCIR Green, SCIR Blue, or SCIR grey require a minimum quantity purchase.

Minimum order quantity for LEXAN™ THERMOCLICK™ 40mm is 2,730 sq ft. (43 sheets at 19.685" wide x 464.4" long)

Minimum order quantity for LEXAN™ THERMOCLICK™ 50mm is 2,032 sq ft. (16 sheets 39.37" wide x 464.4" long)
