

Ask the Tech Expert



Q: What is a roof purlin?

A: A purlin is a horizontal structural member often made from wood or steel that directly supports the roofing material.

Purlins run perpendicular to the slope of the roof as opposed to rafters that run parallel to the slope of the roof.

Purlins transfer the roof load to the main roof structure such as trusses, load bearing walls, or large rafters.

Purlins vary in size depending on the type of structure, loading requirements, and local codes.

The spacing between purlins depends on the type of roofing material, loading requirements, and local codes.

Always check first with your local building inspector or local code requirements.

DIY Tip of the Month



"Sealants"

Only use a "100% silicone" sealant on polycarbonate sheets.

Silicone sealants do not degrade in sunlight. They resist mold and mildew and remain flexible, allowing for building movement.

Do not use roofing caulk.

Consequences of using an incompatible sealant are inadequate adhesion or too rigid of a bond.

Incompatible products contains chemicals that may discolor or damage the polycarbonate sheet.

NOTE: Check the product information on the sealant label <u>BEFORE</u> using to ensure compatibility!
