

Shear Walls & Diaphragms



Q: Can LEXAN™ THERMOCLEAR™ multiwall polycarbonate panels act as shear walls or diaphragms?

A. No, LEXAN™ THERMOCLEAR™ multiwall polycarbonate panels should not be used as shear walls or diaphragms per APA design and construction recommendations.


The panels should only be used as non-structural members in the buildings overall design.

Typically horizontal and designed to take high structural loads, a diaphragm is a flat structural element (roof or floor) that transmits lateral loads to the vertical resisting elements of a structure.

Shear walls are vertical elements within a building that provide lateral shear strength and large stiffness, reducing lateral sway and structural damage from seismic activity and extreme winds.

A Good Thermal Insulator: Multiwall Polycarbonate



rectangular hollow structure "flutes" that run the length of the sheet. The flutes trap air between the sheet's layers, providing excellent insulation properties. Thermal insulation can help keep a building warm in the winter and cool in the summer. The amount of thermal insulation a multiwall sheet provides is indicated by the sheets R-value. The more layers the polycarbonate sheet has, the better thermal insulation or R-value it provides.
