

CHAMCLAD® HANDLING GUIDE

CHAMCLAD® TRANSPORTATION

When transporting ChamClad® products, keep panels flat. Panels must be supported along the full length of the panel. Material must be inspected before install. Report any issues within 7 days of receiving the product and forward to info@chamclad.com or contact your local distributor.

PROPER HANDLING

- To avoid chipping, cut panels with an aluminum blade and the panel face down. Avoid cutting at high speeds.
- Ensure low profile fasteners are used. Fasteners are available at ChamClad® and through your local distributor.
- Avoid metal banding as metal banding will cut into boards if pulled too tight.

STORAGE OF CHAMCLAD®

- Do not place or store on asphalt or in excessive heat build up areas.
- Store panels on a flat surface that supports the entire length of the panels.
- Product should be kept dry and out of direct sunlight.
- It is important that product is not stored where temperatures could exceed 30 degrees celsius (86 degrees Fahrenheit) for long periods of time.
- It is best to store ChamClad® panels in the shade; otherwise should be covered with a tarp leaving the ends open for air circulation.
- For warranty coverage, please ensure all installation practices are followed according to the installation manual.
