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Intent of Evaluation

An evaluation of Vision Profiles Extrusion's VE 1004 was conducted in order to determine the overall safety of this material when used in rooms where food is manufactured, stored, packaged, reviewed, and/or shipped. The finished material is not intended to have direct contact with food. This report is intended to provide an overall summary of the evaluation. This evaluation is limited to the ingredients provided by Vision Profile Extrusions. Any other ingredients not provided shall be outside the scope of this evaluation.

Evaluation of VE 1004 for food-zone non-contact

NSF International has reviewed each ingredient of this material to determine if the ingredient can be considered safe for its intended use. Since this material is intended for use in facilities that process or store food, but is not intended for direct contact with food, the following review criteria was used:

- Ingredients listed in 21 CFR Parts 170 – 186 were deemed acceptable. Since these ingredients are listed in 21 CFR for direct or indirect contact with food or for direct addition to food, these ingredients are considered acceptable for use in materials that do not contact food.
- Absence of the following intentionally added substances was confirmed:
 - Cadmium, lead, mercury, and arsenic
 - Herbicides, pesticides, and bactericides
- Use level was sufficiently low to not be expected to become a component of food at any significant level.

Based on this review, it has been determined that this material is composed of substances that are not reasonably expected to become a component of food at levels that would be considered unsafe when used in rooms where food is manufactured, stored, packaged, reviewed, and/or shipped. The finished material is not intended to have direct contact with food.
